**YOUTH TRANSITION COUNSELLOR**

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Under the direction of the EUTC Program Manager, the Youth Transition Counsellor will focus on working with Indigenous Youth aging out of the Child Welfare system. Working with First Nation communities and organizations and other relevant stakeholders to obtain statistics as to how many Indigenous children are aging out of care. Key activities include working with youth mentors, developing screening tools, developing procedures for recruiting and referrals, developing and coordinating activities, creating individual plans with Indigenous Youth aging out of care.

**QUALIFICATIONS**

- A minimum of an undergraduate degree in the field of social services, or a combination of related education and training will be considered.
- Extensive work experience in a social service environment.
- Knowledge of Aboriginal social issues, economic issues, history and culture.
- Knowledge of Winnipeg services and resources in the areas of housing mental health, counseling, education, income security, children and families, and Aboriginal Culture.
- Excellent communication, written and computer skills (word processing), MS Word, Excel, Power Point, Microsoft Outlook.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills and the ability to work independently and co-operatively as part of an interdisciplinary team are required.
- Assess needs and make appropriate referrals, develop strategies for youth support, education and follow-up care.
