Application Process

Please complete the online application form at the following link <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/RJ7BXSB> before May 29, 2020. Ensure your application is complete and all required documents are provided. Incomplete applications may affect your eligibility. The application can be completed via cell phone by scanning the QR code to the right. To help those who may not have the required documents our staff may contact Chief and Council to verify applicants. First Nations from Manitoba that are Winnipeg based citizens who require assistance completing an application may call the EAGLE Urban Transition Centre at 204-954-3050 or toll free 1-866-345-1883. Please be ready to email required documents to amccovid19supports@manitobachiefs.com.

Return calls will be made to those whose Emergency Assistance is completed and ready to be mailed. **Please do not call if you have already registered.**

Financial Assistance

Families provided with financial assistance will receive an AMC TruCash Visa Prepaid/Reloadable Card in the mail. Once the card has been received, the First Nation individual will call the number provided above to verify they received the card and the funds will be loaded to the card. The card can be used just like a Visa.

Safety Kits

Families provided with safety kits will be notified which day the kit will be dropped off. The First Nation individual will verify that they will be home to receive the kit and the kit will be delivered to their door. The delivery driver will leave the package at the door and wait to verify the individual has received the package.

We ask all those participating in this process to be patient with the staff.
