RE: NEGOTIATING TEAM TO FINALIZE NEW HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT WITH HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT CANADA

WHEREAS, Human Resources Development Canada (H.R.D.C.) and various Manitoba First Nation organizations have existing agreements in the area of training and employment, day care and youth that have expired on March 31, 1999; and

WHEREAS, H.R.D.C. has announced the Aboriginal Human Resource Development Strategy to replace existing agreements with Manitoba First Nations organizations. H.R.D.C.'s strategy proposes one five-year comprehensive agreement that includes the following five program areas: Employment and Training, Day Care, Youth, Urban and Disabled; and

WHEREAS, the Grand Chiefs' require a mandate from the Chiefs-in-Assembly to negotiate a new Human Resources Development Agreement with H.R.D.C.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chiefs in Special Assembly authorize the three Grand Chiefs to negotiate a new Human Resources Development Agreement with H.R.D.C.

WHEREAS, the Aboriginal Flexible Funding Arrangement (A.F.F.A.) and the mandate of the R.A.M.B. has expired effective March 31, 1999; and

MOTION CARRIED

WHEREAS, H.R.D.C. wishes to enter into a new Human Resources Development Agreement with the A.M.C. that integrates five program areas (training and employment, daycare, youth, disabled, and urban) into a single agreement.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chiefs in Special Assembly have directed the Grand Chiefs of A.M.C., M.K.O., and S.C.O. to negotiate a new Human Resources Development Agreement; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that A.M.C. will distribute the dollars on an agreed upon funding arrangement as agreed upon by S.C.O. and M.K.O. for distribution in their respective regions effective April 1, 1999.
