**RE: HEALTH FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT**


**WHEREAS**, in February 1991, Chiefs-in-Assembly passed a resolution directing the development of a Framework Agreement on Health; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chiefs Health Committee has worked since that time on a process of consultation, dialogue, development, negotiation and mediation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chiefs Health Committee recommends to the Chiefs-in-Assembly that Draft #6 Health Framework Agreement for First Nations People in Manitoba, as discussed in Assembly today, is supportive of our self-government aspirations in health.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Grand Chief be sanctioned to proceed with signing Draft #6 of the Health Framework Agreement for First Nations People in Manitoba and negotiating administrative and fiscal arrangements with the Minister of Health and Welfare for the next phase.



**WHEREAS**, there is no specific training component identified in Draft #6 of the Health Framework Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, Health Management Training must be recognized as an integral component of the Health Framework Agreement process.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the First Nations Health Management Training Program be one of the training programs that will be fully integrated and complementary to the Health Framework Agreement process.

**RE: DENIAL OF NON-INSURED HEALTH  
BENEFITS**

**WHEREAS**, a member of the St. Theresa Point First Nation had to relocate his residence to Winnipeg; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 27, 1994, this member presented a prescription to a Safeway pharmacy on behalf of his wife who was ill; and

**WHEREAS**, this member presented all the necessary documentation to the Safeway pharmacist but was refused service until two days later when his wife's status as a Registered Indian could be further verified by the pharmacy.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that a letter of protest be sent by Grand Chief Phil Fontaine and Grand Chief George Muswagon to Canada Safeway including the corporate head offices of all pharmacies in Manitoba, and Medical Services Branch regarding this denial of basic health services and the request that this denial cease and desist immediately.
