RE: AMC's Position on Negotiations


Whereas, Education is guaranteed as a Treaty Right under the Treaty making process for sharing of our lands and resources.

Whereas, The Assembly of Manitoba Chiefs is currently in negotiations to recognize the exercise of full jurisdiction over all education matters by the First Nations of Manitoba.

Therefore Be It Resolved, That the position taken by the Assembly of Manitoba Chiefs on behalf of the member First Nations of Manitoba be the direction given to the negotiation team to be followed as a minimum:

1. No Provincial involvement in these agreements negotiated between the federal government and AMC;
2. Local Education Administrative Bodies be respected and their delegated authority by Chief and Council be enhanced through the Education Agreement being negotiated.
3. The Treaty Right to education includes a life-long process for as long as the sun shines, the grass grows and the rivers flow;
4. A comprehensive agreement that includes all existing and future components of education. (List Attached)
